FAQ The Studio (Available March – October)

Contact Information

The Studio is located at the top of the St. Andrew's property at 7550 E. State Route 106, Union, WA, 98592. The apartment has a lockable entrance door and is connected to the Director's residence with a locked interior door separating it. The Studio includes a small bedroom with queen bed, furniture, office space and private bathroom with tub/shower. The St. Andrew's office phone is 360-898-2362. Director Dan Oberg can be reached on his cell at 509-670-1666.

What time can I check in?

Unless other arrangements have been made with us, check-in is any time after 4 p.m. on the day of your arrival. Check-out time is a firm 1 p.m. You will find the entrance door unlocked when you arrive. Your key will be on the counter with other Welcome materials --- when you arrive, please text Dan at 509-670-1666 to let him know.

How many people can stay at the Studio?

The Studio has one small bedroom with a queen-sized bed. In deference to our limited septic system and the Union Fire Department's evaluation, the total sleeping capacity is two adults.

What about parking?

The Studio has a parking space between the two large trees just off the driveway and just below the entrance. Additional parking is available in the main Lodge parking area.

Do I need to bring my pillow? All linens, blankets, pillows, towels, and washcloths are provided for a maximum of two guests. Please do not bring linens, sleeping bags, stuffed animals, and pillows from home. Daily linen service is not included. Extra linens and blankets are stored in the linen closet.

Do I need to bring cooking equipment? The Studio offers a mini-kitchen for your use, including hot water kettle, microwave and small refrigerator, but no sink, except in the bathroom. A limited amount of dishware, which can be collected and replenished at your request, is provided. Coffee filters, tissues, toilet paper and paper towels are provided as well.

What about food or meals?

If there is a group staying at the Lodge, you can choose to purchase meals, but we need to know your plans one week prior to arrival. You can inquire with the Director the meal schedule during the time you staying. Studio guests are responsible for their own food otherwise, and due to the limited cooking facilities, are encouraged is bring simple or pre-prepared foods. There is a gas station/convenience store about 1.5 miles from St. Andrew's, and grocery stores in nearby

Shelton, Hoodsport and Belfair. There are also several great restaurants nearby, such as Union Square Deli, Alderbrook Resort, Alderbrook Golf Club, Hood Canale and Dos Margaritas.

Can I bring Fido? Due to the limited space, we are not able to have pets in the Studio unless they are service animals. Please inform the Director if you need to bring a service animal.

What about the grounds and the beach? You are welcome to wander the grounds and even step into the Lodge, but please be considerate to any groups staying there, especially if they are observing silence. You are encouraged to walk the grounds of our neighbor, Harmony Hill, unless the campus is closed to visitors, in which case there will be a sign saying so. You can also go down the beach, next to Bayne Cottage, but please exercise caution in going down the stairs next to deck, as they get slippery. Remember that the Cottage is likely to have guests, so please be gracious to them by not walking on the deck or making lots of noise when you visit the beach.

Is there a telephone in the Studio? Yes, there is a phone extension of our office phone (with the ringer silenced) for emergency use only. Cell phone reception may vary.

Do you have access to the internet? Yes, wireless password is Lodge123.

What time do I have to leave? Check out time is 1 p.m., unless you have made special arrangements with us for a later check out. We ask that guests strip the beds of the sheets they used and put them in the shower. Please leave blankets and pillows on the bed. The key can be left on the counter and the entrance door left unlocked.
